August 3, 1937 - August 10, 2018

Carl Irvin Day of Alix, Arkansas, died Friday, August 10, 2018, in Fort Smith, Arkansas. He was a retired teacher of 29 years at Altus-Denning Schools, a school bus driver, cattle farmer, and a member of Calvary Baptist Church of Ozark. He was born August 3, 1937, in McNeil, Arkansas, to Seldon and Mary Gilbreath Day. He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, Samuel and Louis Day; and a granddaughter, Angela Payne.

Carl loved his family and particularly enjoyed attending the sporting events and performances of his grandchildren, nieces, and nephews.
