



## Reverend David Hughes King

June 17, 1939 - October 1, 2020

Reverend David Hughes King, 81, of Ozark, Arkansas, died October 1, 2020 at his home in Ozark. He was the Pastor of Union Assembly of God Church in Paris, Arkansas since 1973. He was a helicopter mechanic in the Military and retired in 1964 after serving 4 years. He was a local Parts Manager until he retired at age 62.

He was born June 17, 1939 in Yell County Arkansas to Reverend Otha Leon and Ruedean Wilson King. He was preceded in death by his loving wife JoAnn of 56 years, an infant son and his parents.

He is survived by his two daughters, Teresa Vanover of Clarksville, Arkansas and Shari Grigsby of Ozark and his son David Anthony King of Ozark; three brothers, Loyd Lee King of Benton City, Washington, Jerry Daniel King of Gore, Oklahoma and Clinton Dean King of Ozark; nine grandchildren; and nine great grandchildren.

Funeral service will be held Monday, October 5th at 2:00 PM at the First Assembly of God Church in Paris, Arkansas with Brother Nathan King, Brother J.D. King and Brother Wayne Thacker officiating.
