We are going to leave" so I've used that line when buying cars the past 30 plus years. Well they negotiated and it came down to \$50 bucks (yes only \$50 more than we'd decided to give for the car) he said "let's go Dennis" (yes he knew I wanted the car bad) and we got up to leave.. The salesman said "are you going to lose this deal over \$50" and of course Gayle said "We sure are" and my heart sunk!!!! We got to the door and the salesman said "ok, ok.. I give, you can have it for that". I was excited to say the least..., later I asked Gayle if we were going to actually leave and he said "absolutely".... And that basically we had agreed to the amount we would pay for the car and he was going to stick to it! I learned so much that day... That was Gayle, he was just a kind hearted soul, that spent his life (AARP Taxes is a great example) helping and teaching other's. If they were his blood or not, he was always there for you!! I will never forget you Gayle Duane Mitchell (Big Goon) I got nothing but love for you!!! RIP Sorry this is so lengthy
