ARGIE HAZEL MILTON, AGE 87, OF OZARK DIED MONDAY, JUNE 28TH IN OZARK. SHE WAS A RETIRED CHURCH ADMINISTRATOR FOR FIRST METHODIST CHURCH IN EMPORIA KANSAS FOR 29 YEARS; A MEMBER OF FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH OF OZARK, PAST PRESIDENT OF THE OZARK CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, A FOUNDING MEMBER OF THE KIWANIS CLUB IN OZARK; MEMBER OF THE ORIGINAL OZARK COMMITTEE, EARNED NUMEROUS AWARDS TRAINING CUB SCOUT LEADERS; SERVED AS PRESIDENT OF UNITED METHODIST WOMEN FOR 13 YEARS, 3 YEARS AS PRESIDENT OF W.S.C.S.; MEMBER OF NORTH FRANKLIN COUNTY ASSN; O.E.S. MIRIAM CHAPTER AND S.O.O.B. HER LIFE EXEMPLIFIED THE APOSTLE PAUL'S ADMONITION THAT YOUR FAITH SHOULD LEAD YOU TO DO GOOD WORKS. HAZEL WAS BORN JUNE 1, 1923 IN THE WATALULA COMMUNITY, THE DAUGHTER OF E. Z. & BONNIE BASKIN DICKERSON. SHE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HER PARENTS AND 2 BROTHERS, EDGAR DICKERSON AND JOHN DICKERSON.
