Beverly Helen O'Leary was a committed Ozarkian who died Friday, November 12, 2010, peacefully in her sleep, after a long bout with cancer.

Beverly, born June 11, 1934, was the grandchild of Mildred Edwards, and was raised by her uncle and aunt, Walter and Helen Klemp Duerr, in Pasadena, CA where she was educated and became a programming engineer.

Most of her working career was spent as an independent programming contractor, servicing clients coast-to-coast, including Anchorage, Alaska, Seattle, Washington, Pittsburg, San Francisco and Los Angeles. Her last engagement before retiring in 1995 to her home in the Ozarks was doing multiple projects for Sutter Health of California.

Beverly was married and divorced from Rome J. Dearman (Walker) also a native of the Ozarks, although they lived together mostly in Los Angeles and Alaska.
