Billy Gayle Shankle age 76 passed away surrounded by family at his home in Ozark, Arkansas Tuesday, September 21, 2021 in Ozark. Known by his handle “Whipper Snapper” he was a cross-country truck driver and later transitioned to the oilfield retiring after 50 years; as well as maintaining his CDL, he was a skilled heavy equipment operator, pusher, owner of Shankle Field Services and ultimately retiring as a salesman for Samco. An All-around cowboy; he enjoyed his time on the rodeo circuit, team roping and riding an occasional bull. Bill was an avid outdoorsman; hunting, camping with his family and friends especially fishing from his flat bottom boat. Above all his greatest treasure was his family, whom he cherished most. He was a member of the Mt. Zion Baptist Church. Bill was born June 5, 1945 in Wagoner, Oklahoma to W.B. “Bill” and Wilma L. Simpson Shankle.
