Billy Gene Spyres, age 79, of Ozark, Arkansas, passed away Saturday, May 17, 2025, in Ozark. He was born November 23, 1945, in Prairie Grove, Arkansas, to John Henry Spyres and Wanda Lee Summerlin Spyres.
