Bobby Dean Brown went to be with the Lord at 10:26 AM on Tuesday, February 28, 2017 at the age of 88. He was born February 21, 1929 in Weatherford, Oklahoma to the late Herbert and Kathleen Love Brown. He was owner and operator of the A & H Café in Ozark for over 30 years and was also retired from Harding Glass Company in Ft. Smith. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Ozark and a Korean Veteran of the US Army, a recipient of the Purple Heart.
