Byron A. Lasater IV, age 60, of Ozark, Arkansas died Wednesday, June 5, 2024 in Little Rock, Arkansas. He was born March 9, 1964 in Ada, Oklahoma to Byron A. Lasater III and Nancy Sue Andrews Lasater. Byron was a union representative for Whirlpool, a special education teacher and a certified rehabilitation counselor. 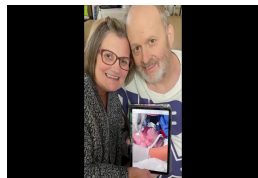
