Catina Lynn Styers, age 54 of Winslow, Arkansas was called home to Our Lord and Savior on Saturday, February 1, 2025 after a hard-fought battle with Stiff Person Syndrome. She was born May 3, 1970 in Palm Springs, California. She attended Charleston High School in Charleston, Arkansas. She worked as a medical assistant at Ozark Dermatology, former Dr. Ginger Dermatology, for 23 years before she left to care for her husband during his battle with cancer. After he passed, she began working towards her dream of becoming a nurse, but that dream was stalled after her SPS diagnosis.

Catina loved all things related to nature: all animals big and small, four-leaf clovers and flowers (especially sunflowers), and brilliant, vibrant sunsets. She loved the cold air on a snowy, winter day and the buzz of the bees and butterflies flittering among the flowers on a spring day. She loved the changing of the leaves in the fall and the warmth of the sun in the summer. She was a true admirer of all of God's wonderful creations. Catina's faith and love for God was her guiding light and source of strength to get her through the challenges she faced throughout her life.

Catina is preceded in death by her parents, W.D. and Patty House; her husband, Donald Styers; her niece, Amber Binz; and one brother-in-law, Lane Wilson.

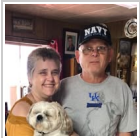

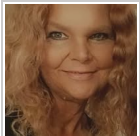
