BORN JULY 7, 1929 IN ALTUS, AR , THE SON OF THE LATE ELMER T. AND ARCHIE B. CARTER. CLAUD WAS A GRADUATE OF ALTUS HIGH SCHOOL AND JOINED THE ARMY AIR FORCE IN JULY 1947. HE TOOK HIS BASIC TRAINING AT LACKLAND AFB, TX. HIS ASSIGNMENTS INCLUDED LONDON, ENGLAND; MITCHELL AFB, NEW YORK; WRIGHT-PATTERSON AFB, OHIO; DHAHRAN, SAUDI ARABIA; ANDREWS AFB, MARYLAND; HEADQUARTERS, U.S. AIR FORCE, THE PENTAGON (3 TIMES), AND LOWREY AFB, DENVER, COLORADO. HE WAS AN HONOR GRADUATE OF THE USAF STENOGRAPHIC SCHOOL AND USAF LEADERSHIP SCHOOL. HE RECEIVED THE RANK OF TECHNICAL SERGEANT AND WAS AWARDED THE AIR FORCE COMMENDATION MEDAL AND RETIRED FROM THE AIR FORCE IN OCTOBER 1969. HE THEN WORKED FOR THE US POSTAL SERVICE IN WASHINGTON, DC, WHERE HE RETIRED IN 1987 AND MOVED TO OZARK WHERE HE SPENT HIS RETIREMENT YEARS. HE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HIS PARENTS AND FIVE BROTHERS: TRUMAN, GARNER, WILLARD, MAURICE, & ALBERT; AND A SISTER, MARGARET. CLAUD UNITED WITH THE ALTUS METHODIST CHURCH AT AN EARLY AGE AND WAS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE CHURCH THROUGHOUT HIS LIFETIME. HE WAS VERY GENEROUS WITH HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CHURCH AND HE SUPPORTED THE CHURCH WITH HIS PRESENCE, PRAYERS, & SERVICE. CLAUD WAS ALSO KNOWN FOR HIS GENEROSITY TO

PERSONS IN NEED, OFTEN PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THOSE WHO WERE FACING TOUGH TIMES. SURVIVORS INCLUDE 2 DAUGHTERS: ANGELA BARBARA OF LONDON, ENGLAND & GLENDA MARIE SITNIK OF FLORIDA; 2 SONS, CLAUD LOREN CARTER OF LAUREL, MD, AND WILLIAM EDWARD CARTER OF WASHINGTON, D.C.
