Corinne King Laughlin was born on July 10, 1919, in Ozark, Arkansas, and she died on Tuesday, January 15, 2013 at her life-long family home on King's Mountain in Ozark. She resided in Fort Smith, Arkansas from 1940 until 2008 when she moved back to Ozark. She attended school in Ozark and in Okemah, Oklahoma, before graduating from Denver East High School in 1936. At the University of Arkansas, she was a Razorback cheerleader in the fall of 1937 and was initiated as a member of Chi Omega Fraternity in January, 1938. She was a supportive member of Chi Omega for 78 years. Corinne loved dancing and was a dance teacher for several years, an adviser to the cheerleading squad at Ramsey Junior High School and the founder and first director of the drill team at Southside High School in Fort Smith, Arkansas. She was an avid bridge player throughout her life, and could often be found Wednesday afternoons playing cards with good friends at Hardscrabble Country Club. She loved parties and had many cherished friends. She married Cecil Laughlin, Jr., in 1939 in Dallas, Texas, before moving to Fort Smith. Corinne was a homemaker and mother to her six children for many years before she was employed as an interior decorator for the Norman Company. In 1963 she opened Corinne Laughlin Interiors and operated this business until her retirement in 2003. Corinne loved to travel, both with friends on memorable trips and also with her brother Carter, with whom she visited destinations throughout the Western United States, Hawaii, and the Far East. Corinne was preceded in death by her parents, Carter B.
