DeMona Mae Beasley Reeves, 84, of Ozark, Arkansas, died peacefully at her home Monday, June 5, 2017 in Ozark. She was a retired bookkeeper and Master Geneologist, a member of First Christian Church Disciples of Christ, a member and former State President and State Chaplain of American Legion Women's Auxiliary, a Girl Scout and Cub Scout leader and member of Extension Homemakers Club for fifty- nine years.
