Dennis R. Whitson II, 92, of Mulberry, Arkansas died Friday, July 5, 2013 in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was a member of the Rehobeth Missionary Baptist Church and an ordained Minister of the Missionary Baptist Church for 58 years. He was a WWII veteran and a recipient of the Purple Heart and the Bronze Star. He was a member of General Patton's Third Army and was in the Civilian Conservation Corps.
