She raised her family with her husband Dean Bull in Rogers then moved to Ozark in 1990. She was preceded in death by her parents, a brother, Lloyd Kiper of Rogers, Arkansas and a sister, Juanita Hanby of Berryville, Arkansas. . Doye had a long and varied life.
