Edgar Cagle, age 92, passed away on Thursday, April 18, 2019 in Fort Smith, Arkansas. He was born June 9, 1926 in Jethro, Arkansas to John Riley and Clara Standridge Cagle. He was preceded in death by his wife, Goldie Williams Cagle; his parents; a sister, Mildred Nordin; a brother, Freddie Cagle. He was a World War II Veteran having served with the 801st Engineer Aviation Division of the United States Army, being honorably discharged on November 15, 1946.
