Floia Alome Hood, 92, of Rockwall, Texas formerly of Ozark, Arkansas died Saturday, March 23, 2019 in Texas. She was a retired Produce Farmer with Jackson & Perkins Rose Farms, a former member of the Ozark Senior Center, and attended Lake Point Church in Rockwall where she enjoyed the Women's Life Group. Floia's family went to California for work in the late 1930's settling in Wasco, California. In 1946, she met Selmer Hood, originally from Ozark, Arkansas; at that time he was working for Superior Oil Co. later bought by Mobile Oil. In July of 1948 Floia married the love of her life, Selmer Hood and went on to have two children. They lived in Wasco until retirement in 1979 and moved to Ozark where they built a house on Hood property out on Hwy 23 and sold produce from their garden for the next twenty nine years. She was born May 4, 1926 in Okemah, Oklahoma to Jerry and Dicie Smith Ricketts. She was preceded in death by her husband of sixty years, Selmer Hood; her parents; a son, Johnnie W. Hood; two sisters, Ruby Chambers and Oleta Smith; and a grandson, Jason P. Barter.

Floia is survived by her daughter, Cynthia Barter and husband Peter of Rockwall; a sister, Verla Mae Bingham; a brother, Roy Ricketts; a grandchild, Jennifer E. Wagner and husband Scott; and four great grandchildren, Ethan, Aidan, and Logan Wagner, and Micah Barter.
