September 11, 1919 - September 5, 2012

Floy Kilgore Shastid, 92, of Ozark, Arkansas, died Wednesday, September 5, 2012 in Conway, Arkansas. He was born September 11, 1919 in Yale, Arkansas by the Franklin and Johnson County Line to Floy B. and Dexter M. Kilgore Shastid. Due to his father's health, his family moved to Lincoln, Nebraska when he was nine years old. He graduated from Lincoln High School in 1938. He lived in New York after graduation and moved to California in 1941. He worked at Lockheed Martin where he met his wife Evelyn Terhark. They married June 10, 1945. Shortly after the birth of their daughter, the family moved to Rock Rapids, Iowa, where they owned the Snack Shoppe. They moved back to his beloved Arkansas in 1953. In Ozark they operated the Tot N' Teen Shop. He later went to work at the post office from which he retired in 1981. He was a board member of First United Methodist Church, a member of the Lions Club and NARFE. He will be remembered for his quick wit, unique sayings and the respect and kindness he showed to all. He was preceded in death by his parents; his sister, Melba Taylor and his wife of sixty two years, Evelyn. Funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM, Friday, September 7, 2012 at Shaffer Chapel with C.A. Kuykendall officiating with private burial at Highland Cemetery in Ozark under the direction of Shaffer Funeral Home. He is survived by his daughter, Jerri Wedge and husband Stan; his grandson, Doug Wedge and wife Shawn; four great grandchildren, Jack, Sloan, Sophie and Sadie.
