January 3, 1934 - July 19, 2021

Francis "Frank" Jaques Hiles, II age 87, of Ozark, Arkansas died Monday, July 19, 2021 in Fort Smith, Arkansas. He was a Navy Chief Petty Officer, veteran of WWII, Korea and Vietnam, a member of the famous Seawolves Helicopter Squadron in the Mekong Delta, life member of the National Rifle Association, licensed private pilot, former officer in the Civil Air Patrol, former pipe welder for Ace Mechanical of Altus, Arkansas, retired business owner of Tri-City Repair in Ozark and helped originate the Bargains Galore on 64 Annual Yard Sale. He was born January 3, 1934 in Cleveland, Ohio to Francis Jaques and Helen Cappel Hiles. He is preceded in death by his parents; a sister, Helen Hiles; and a son Charles Arthur Hiles.
