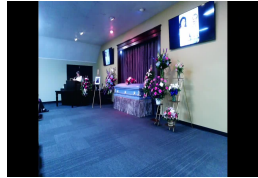
Mom and Ben raised very unique and wonderful people and Mom always shared how proud she was of each of them for who they are.

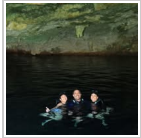
