Glenda Nell Cunningham Scott, age 76, of Ozark, Arkansas passed away on Thursday, October 2, 2025 in Charleston, Arkansas. Glenda was born on March 10, 1949 in Lake Village, Arkansas to Glendon Ralph “Glen” Cunningham and Dorothy Nell Hollis Cunningham.

Glenda was a stay at home mom and military wife during her early adult years, living in many states and abroad until settling close to her family in Ozark in the 1980s where she joined the workforce at Walmart. Even once she was at her new home at Greenhurst she walked the halls like she owned the place making new friends of the Staff, residents and families as she was constantly blazing a trail throughout the facility at all hours of the day and night offering smiles to all.

Glenda was known throughout her community as a strong and faithful Christian and a prayer warrior for any soul in need. Her favorite role was that of mother and grandmother and her grandchildren gravitated toward her at every possible chance because she would sit and play with them for as long as they wanted. She was Grammy and Mimi, depending on which grandchild you ask.

Family meant everything to her and the bigger the gathering the happier she was. Even after her memory was fading when surrounded by family, her joy was evident through her bright smiling eyes. She didn't always know what was going on at that point but she was still content because she was in a room with all the people she loved and that loved her in return.

Glenda is preceded in death by her parents, and her husband of 50 plus years.
