IPHIS BANHART, WAS A RESIDENT OF CRAWFORD HEALTHCARE & REHABILITATION CENTER IN VAN BUREN AND PREVIOUS RESIDENT OF THE OZARK NURSING HOME. IPHIS WAS BORN IN SPADRA, AR, ON JANUARY 16, 1916 AND GREW UP IN THE ALTUS-DENNING COMMUNITY. HE WAS A WORLD WAR II VETERAN AND SERVED HIS COUNTRY AS A SERGEANT IN COMPANY B 309TH ENGINEERS 84TH DIVISION. HE WAS AWARDED THREE BRONZE SERVICE STARS, A PURPLE HEART, A GOOD CONDUCT MEDAL AND A BRONZE STAR MEDAL; HE WAS A VFW MEMBER; A MEMBER OF FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH IN MULBERRY WHERE HE LIVED MOST OF HIS LIFE, OWNING AND OPERATING A LOCAL SERVICE STATION AND POULTRY BUSINESS; HE ALSO WORKED FOR ALLEN CANNING COMPANY. AFTER RETIRING HE ENJOYED HIS FAVORITE HOBBIES OF FISHING AND GARDENING. IPHIS WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HIS PARENTS LEWIS AND MINNIE CLEETON BANHART, EIGHT BROTHERS AND SISTERS, HIS WIFE, OPAL IRENE BEARDEN BANHART AND HIS DAUGHTER SHARON KAY EDGIN.
