Jesse Lynn Day, 70, of Ozark, Arkansas, died Wednesday, May 27, 2015 in Ozark. He was retired, after his former employment in California with International Paper and All Pure Chemical. He was a cattleman-rancher and owner of Ozark Mini Storage. He was a member of West Park Baptist Church and a veteran of the US Air Force; he was a member of American Legion, past president and board member of Pleasant View Fire Department, past president and member of Franklin County Cattlemen's Association; Modesto Lion's Club, Ozark Area Chamber of Commerce, the National Rifle Association.
