



## Jesse Clayton Suit

June 9, 1984 - May 28, 2024

Jesse Clayton Suit, age 39, of Ozark and Fayetteville, Arkansas, died Tuesday, May 28, 2024 in Fayetteville. He was born June 9, 1984 in Blytheville, Arkansas to John Ivan, Jr. and Sherry Lynn Reddell Suit. Jesse was a disabled U.S. Army veteran who served in Iraq with the 82nd Airborne Division at Camp Taqaddam during the First Battle of Fallujah.

He was an Ozark High School graduate, an avid kayaker, made 12 parachute jumps, and was a pretty good guitar player and a carpenter.

He was preceded in death by his mother; maternal grandfather James Clayton Reddell; paternal grandfather John Ivan Suit, Sr.; paternal grandmother, Dottie Lee Harrison Suit; two aunts, Jimmie Carol Reddell Rutz and Diane Sanders.
