Jim Gueen Farmer III, 77, passed away on Tuesday, February 3, 2026, at his home in Aspen, Colorado, with his children by his side. He was born in North Little Rock, Arkansas, to Jim Gueen Farmer Jr. and Ella Jane Farmer.

Jim was a man of drive, grit, and loyalty—steady in his convictions and dependable in every season of life. He was disciplined, strong-willed, and quietly generous, with a presence that made others feel grounded. Just as notable as his work ethic was the way he showed up for the people he loved: Jim built friendships that began in high school and college and lasted a lifetime, remaining close with friends who were truly like family.

He built a successful career after getting his start in banking, and he carried that same determination into every part of his life. A lifelong athlete, he played cornerback for the University of Arkansas and graduated in 1971. He loved football, and he also found joy outdoors—skiing, golfing, running, and hiking—especially in the mountains he called home.

More than anything, he was a devoted father—steady, proud, and deeply loved. His family will miss his presence, his strength, and the way he made life feel anchored.

He is preceded in death by his parents.

Jim is survived by his children, James P. Farmer of Fayetteville, Arkansas; Christopher G. Farmer of Nashville, Tennessee; and Jennifer G. Farmer of Aspen, Colorado; and his grandchildren, Grayson P. Famer and Molly Kate Farmer, both of Fayetteville, Arkansas.

A graveside service will be held March 7, 2026, at 2:00 P.M. at the New Cemetery in Mulberry, Arkansas, under the direction of Shaffer Funeral Home.
