



Dr. John Edward Lachowsky III

January 3, 1949 - June 8, 2023

Dr. John E. Lachowsky III, age 74, died peacefully, surrounded by his family, on Thursday, June 8, 2023 in Altus, Arkansas. He was born January 3, 1949 in Fayetteville, Arkansas to John Edward Lachowsky and Mildred Kate Lachowsky. Dr. Lachowsky graduated from Subiaco Academy in 1967, the University of Arkansas in 1972, and the University of Arkansas for Medical Science in 1976. He was a retired physician. He is preceded in death by his parents; one brother, William Allen Lachowsky; one sister, Virginia Porterfield; and one grandson, Callum Edward Lachowsky.
