December 25, 1965 - July 20, 2012

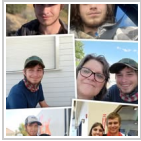

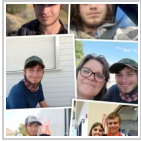

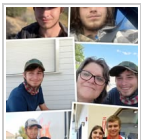
