Kenneth Guthrie, 87, of Ozark, Arkansas, died Saturday, November 19, 2016 in Fort Smith, Arkansas. He was born August 27, 1929 in Altus, Arkansas to Harve and Jewel Gowing Guthrie. He served in the U.S. Army four and a half years and was stationed in Germany. Kenneth met his wife, Delma, in Superior, Wyoming while working in the coal mines. They married January 25, 1951.
