Marjorie Lane Caulk Haberer, 100, of Little Rock, Arkansas formerly of Ozark, Arkansas, went to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Saturday, October 11, 2025 in Little Rock, Arkansas. She was born on December 31, 1924 to Carl and Ruth England Caulk in Caulksville, Arkansas.

Marjorie was a graduate of Ozark High School and Arkansas Tech University in Russellville, Arkansas. She met Albert Haberer after he came home from WWII. They married in 1947 and had four children. She was a long-time member of the First Presbyterian Church in Ozark, where she taught children's Sunday school for more than 15 years and played the piano. She sang in the church choir until she and Albert moved to Little Rock. Marjorie was a stay-at-home mom and her children were the benefactors of that decision. She was very involved in her children's activities: band boosters, girl scout cookie chairman, and other school activities.

She is preceded in death by her husband of 70 years, Albert Haberer; her parents; and one granddaughter, Natalie Lane Calaway.
