Marshall was a Construction Owner for Ozark Material and Chrisman and Son, a Tug Boat Captain, Pilot, Chairman of the Franklin County Ozark Airport, former State Representative of 1968 to 1969, a member of the Ozark Recreation Club, the Eagles and the 32 Degree Mason.
