Reverend John D. Minyard III, 72, of Ozark, Arkansas died Thursday, February 15, 2018 in Ozark. He was a retired Minister, a member of Jethro Pentecostal Church, Heavy equipment operator, and a Vietnam Veteran of the United States Air Force.
