



## Robert Harlan Agee

June 18, 1939 - September 16, 2010

Robert Harlan Agee, age 71, of Ozark, AR, passed away Thursday, September 16, 2010 at his home. He was a retired General Manager of the Arkansas Valley Electric Co-op. Robert, a native of Ozark, began his career in October 1960 as an assistant work order clerk. He served in various positions during his 40-year career including work order supervisor, district manager of the Waldron district office and his last 20 years as general manager of the Ozark headquarters. During this time he served as former chairman of the Arkansas Electric Cooperative, Inc. (AECI) Board and Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation (AECC) Board and as former director ERMCO. He served as President of the Ozark Recreation Club; a member of the Mercy Foundation of Development Council; and was President of the Ozark FFA Community Supporters.
