Dr. Robert Lane Wilson age 67, of Ozark, Arkansas, died, Friday, October 6, 2023, in Ozark. He was born April 2, 1956 in Beebe, Arkansas to Robert P. Wilson and Rosalene Bullard Wilson. Dr. Wilson grew up in Jacksonville, Arkansas where he later graduated with honors at Jacksonville High School. He furthered his education by attending the University of Central Arkansas in Conway, Arkansas graduating from UCA with honors in 1977. He began medical school in 1982 and was elected to the Alpha Omega Honorary Society finishing up once again with honors. Dr. Wilson performed his residency at UAMS Fort Smith, Arkansas Area Health Education finishing in 1982 and then began practicing Family Medicine in July of 1982. He met and married his lovely wife Anita in 1984 and they have been married for 39 years. In 2021, after 36 years of working with families in Family Medicine, Dr. Wilson retired due to health concerns. He loved to hunt and was an ethical hunter, loved to plant trees, and loved his family. He was a Christian. His friends and family will truly miss him.

Dr. Wilson is preceded in death by his parents; one daughter, Amber Binz; and one brother, Roland Dale Wilson.

Dr. Wilson is survived by his wife, Anita House Wilson; son, Chad Binz and wife Nancy and granddaughter, Bailey Lou of Altus, Arkansas; daughter, Celeste Binz Pitts and husband Jeremy and grandchildren, A.J., Kadyn, and

Lincoln of Ozark; son, Robert Jeremiah Wilson and wife Tessa of Ozark and one grandson on the way, Wyatt Lane Wilson; many aunts and uncles; and many cousins and friends.
