ROGER WAYNE PECKENPAUGH, 81 of Altus, Arkansas, died Wednesday, August 5th in Clarksville, Arkansas. He was born September 21, 1938 in Fairmont, Minnesota to Bernard and Dena Steever Peckenpaugh.
