Roman "R.C." Plugge, 85, of Altus, Arkansas died Monday, May 16, 2011 in Fort Smith after a lengthy illness. He was born January 7, 1926 in Hartman, Arkansas to John Plugge and Marie Eveld Plugge. He was preceded in death by his parents and three brothers: Ralph Plugge, Gilbert Plugge and Wilfred Plugge. He is survived by his loving wife and devoted care-giver Antonia "Toni" Post Plugge; four children, Jan Davis and husband Bill of Dallas, Texas; and Roman Plugge, Jr. and wife Sharon of Dallas, Texas; John Plugge and wife Kathy of Houston, Texas; and Christina Dyer and husband Bob of McAllen Texas; sixteen grandchildren, three great grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews. He is also survived by his siblings, Estella Mae Hilton of Clarksville, Arkansas, Delores Wiederkehr of Altus, Arkansas, and Richard Plugge of Hartman, Arkansas, and sisters-in-law Shirley Plugge of Clarksville, Arkansas and Josephine Plugge of Chicago, Illinois. Roman served in the United States Army European Theater during World War II and was awarded the Bronze Star Medal and a Purple Heart. He graduated from Washington University in St. Louis, Missouri with a degree in architecture. He began his career in Chicago, Illinois, then moved to Dallas, Texas and worked with Grayson Gill, Inc. for over 30 years. He and his wife, Toni, returned to Arkansas in 2000. They are members of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Altus. A rosary service will be held Thursday, May 19th at St. Mary's Church in Altus, Arkansas at 7:00 PM. Funeral Mass will be at 11:00 AM, Friday, May 20th at St. Mary's Church, with Abbot Jerome Kodell, OSB, officiating. Burial service
