



Tammie Sue Schubarth

August 13, 1957 - September 26, 2023

Tammie Sue Schubarth, age 66 of Ozark, went to her heavenly home on September 26, 2023. Tammie lived in Oark for 31 years as a successful homemaker, a substitute teacher, and a bus driver for Oark Public Schools for 7 years before moving to Ozark 16 years ago. She was a 15-year employee of the Franklin County Learning Center working as a baby rocker in the childcare center and a bus driver. Tammie's hobbies included quilting, cooking, visiting with friends and family, and traveling. She was an avid reader of works by Agatha Christie, Louis L' Amour, LM Montgomery, and Louisa May Alcott. Tammie was often referred to by her husband, children, and grandchildren as "Betty Crocker", a seamstress extraordinaire, the chicken wrangler, a snake tamer, a domestic engineer, and a sharpshooter.

Tammie was born in Jacksonville, Florida, on August 13, 1957, to Nelavyn Ophelia Owen Paulson and William Henry Paulson. She married Charles Russell Schubarth in Fayetteville, Arkansas, on June 20, 1976.

Tammie is survived by her husband of 47 years, Charles Russell Schubarth of Ozark; son Charles Raymond Schubarth and wife Lanie Peppas Schubarth of Ozark; daughter Heidi Loree Schubarth Watt and husband Michael Watt of Oklahoma City, son Seth William Schubarth and wife Janice Baugus Schubarth of Clarksville; and daughter Sarah Jane Schubarth of Yukon. Tammie is also survived by 11 grandchildren: Jared Elizondo Peña and wife Keanna, Daina Lorraine, Liam Drew, and Zoey Adele Schubarth, Ryan Harry and Megan Sue Watt, Jesalyn Paige, Zachary Russell, Evelyn Rose, and Allison Lynn Schubarth, Carter Henry Ward and one great grandchild, Adonis Peña; one sister, Rhonda Lynn Paulson of Florida; and one niece, Melissa Tinsley of Kansas.
