Thomas DeWayne McCormick, Sr., 72, of Ozark died Saturday, October 6, 2018 in Fort Smith, Arkansas. He was a retired Foreman of Arkansas Highway Transportation Department; served in the U.S. Army; and attended First Baptist Church in Ozark.
