Ms. Trecie Lee Thomas of Ozark, Arkansas, died on January 14, 2014 at Mercy Clinic Palliative Care Center in Fort Smith, Arkansas surrounded by her loving family after a brief illness. She was born February 6, 1921 in the Mineral Hill Community near Shores Lake and was 92 years, 11 months and 8 days old at her passing. Since becoming a widow in 1986, she lived alone, taking care of her home and large yard and driving herself almost everywhere she went until just recently. She was the happiest when working in her yard on a nice day. She could frequently be

seen weed-eating, picking up fallen limbs, or mowing using one of her two riding lawn mowers. As she often said she rowed her own canoe. Trecie cherished her children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces and cousins, and good friends. She will be greatly missed and always remembered by us all.
