Troy Wayne Clark, age 86, of Ozark, Arkansas died Wednesday, February 16, 2022 in Ozark. He served in the Army, retired from CPA practice, taught Accounting at the University of the Ozarks, worked for Wiederkehr Wine Cellers as a CEO, was a financial and tax consultant, and a cattle and turkey farmer. Troy was born September 21, 1935 in Samnorwood, Texas to Harlan J. and Millie James Clark. He is preceded in death by his parents.

Troy is survived by his wife Martha Clark of 66 years; one daughter, Linette and husband Nelson Wheeler of Ozark; three sons, Alan Clark and husband Bruce Guthrie of Holiday Island, Arkansas, Wade Clark of Ozark, and Dale Clark of Fort Smith, Arkansas; and two granddaughters, Danielle and Mikayla Wheeler of Lamar, Arkansas.

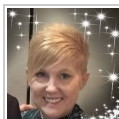
