William "Bill" Charles Young, age 89, of Ozark, Arkansas, passed away, Friday, January 26, 2024 in Ozark. Bill was born July 6, 1934 in Denning, Arkansas to Robert Milburn Young and Effie Adela Huckeby Young. He grew up in the Great Depression on a cotton, corn, soybean, and livestock farm on the Arkansas River, south of Ozark, and learned at an early age you had to work if you wanted to eat. As a young adult, Bill operated a Dairy Farm with his father. He worked at AECC Thomas B. Fitzhugh Generating Station in Ozark until retirement. After retiring he continued his first love of working on his cattle farm. His strong work ethic lasted his entire life. Bill was of the Methodist faith and a member of the Altus First United Methodist Church. He was a Mason, a member of the Cattleman's Association, and a member of the Altus Fraternal Order of Eagles.

Bill is preceded in death by the love of his life, Mary Ann Pillstrom Young; two brothers, Warren and Howard Young; and three sisters, Margie Hopkins, Lois Estes, and Polly Nichols.

Bill is survived by his son, Mark William Young and wife Stacie of Nashville, Tennessee; four daughters, Mary Jane Rofkahr and husband Jim of Altus, Arkansas, Sharla Kay Wiederkehr and husband Dennis of Altus, Cindy Lou Frye and husband Billy of Mansfield, Arkansas, and Betty Rose Neumeier and husband Kurt of Alma, Arkansas; one twin sister, Betty Carter of Springdale,

Arkansas; thirteen grandchildren; twenty-seven great-grandchildren; and six great-great-grandchildren.

“ I am Jimmy Jacobs and i have known Bill for approximately 75 years. Bill went to Greenwood school through the 7th grade and started Altus starting in the 8th grade. I was also in the 8th grade. I always considered Bill as one of my best friends. I have a lot of fond memories of Bill. When I was in high school I went down to Bills to help hauling hay. Bill's father was living at the time and he made some home brew from sugar cane. I dranked a glass of the home brew and fell off the wagon. Bill's father always kidded me about falling off the wagon. One of Bill's favorite stories was an incident at the model cafe when we were in high school. I ordered a 7 up at the cafe. I shook the 7 up and it exploded over Bill and me. The waitress came over and asked if we needed a bib. When we were in high school we had an agriculture teacher named Trez Davis. On one occasion Bill, Johnny Cecil Horn and Carroll Carter went rabbit hunting. Bill and Carroll Carter were in the back seat and the shot gun Bill had went off and shot a hole about the size of a silver dollar in the top of the car.

After graduation from high school Bill, Johnny Cecil Horn and I enrolled in Ark tech college. At the end of first semester Bill decided he just wanted to be a farmer and he dropped out. I also wanted to pursue something else but my mother made me stay in school.

After I retired and returned to Altus, Bill, Mary Ann and I continued our close relationship. We attended Altus Methodist Church and after church we often went to wiederkehr's restaurant. Bill would often look at me before we went in the restaurant and ask me if I had shaved. Most of the times I hadnt shaved and he would say I dont know know if I want to sit by you and he would laugh. Bill had to have knee replacement surgery and on one occasion he asked me to drive him to Nothwest Arkansas for a routine examination. When we started back home Bill said he wanted to stop at Alma and get some ice cream. He almost instantly went to sleep and I almost got to Alma and he was a sleep. I decided not to wake him and almost instantly before we got to the exit in Alma Bill woke up and said turn here.

I have a lot of fond memories of Bill and Mary Ann that i will always cherish.
