Zachary John Lachowsky, age 34, of Bryant, Arkansas passed away, Saturday, November 29, 2024 in Bryant. He was born September 1, 1990 in Fort Smith, Arkansas to Dr. John E. Lachowsky III and Karen Evans Lachowsky. Zach was a member of the St. Mary's Catholic Church in Altus, Arkansas. He graduated from Ozark High School in 2008 and served in the United States Army where he did tours of duty in both Jordan and Iraq.
